


# Why Transformation?

- Ohio Medicaid policy, spending and administration are split across multiple state and local government jurisdictions and poorly coordinated.
- Ohio's health delivery system—particularly related to Medicaid-funded services —  
is inefficient.
- Ohio has no clear point of accountability for overall health system performance.
- Ohio's health system performance must improve:
  - ✓ Ohio is 37th in children who are overweight
  - ✓ Ohio is 42nd in infant mortality
  - ✓ Ohio is 44th in breast cancer deaths and 38th in colorectal cancer deaths
  - ✓ Ohio spends more per person than all but 13 states
- Ohio taxpayers, consumers and families demand better outcomes and better value.

# Ohio's Opiate Addiction Epidemic

- Crisis of unparalleled proportions
  - ✓ More accidental deaths than vehicle crashes since 2007 *(Source: ODH)*
  - ✓ Opiates culpable in 40% of all overdose deaths (1,373) in 2009. *(Source: ODH)*
- 2010 = high-water mark of opiate addiction in Ohio.
- Scioto County is the 'Tip of the Spear'
- 9.7 million doses dispensed in Scioto County during 2010. That's 123 doses for every man, woman and child.



Opiates+	270	371	479	399	556	648	722	784	915





## Ohio's Plan of Attack

- Governor's Visit to Portsmouth & Press Conference – 2/21/11
  - ✓ Announced new funding for Opiate Treatment Center
  - ✓ Executive Order 2011-06K – Expansion of Medication Assisted Treatment
  - ✓ Creation of Multi-Departmental Task-Force Led by former Ohio Attorney General Betty Montgomery
- HB 93 – Sponsored by Reps. Dave Burke, Terry Johnson and Danny Bulp
  - ✓ Cracks down on illegal 'pill mills'
  - ✓ Changes to pain clinic licensure, regulations
  - ✓ Tightens prescriber regulations
  - ✓ Strengthens Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System (OARRS)
  - ✓ Requires statewide prescription medicine 'take-back' program
